Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the February 21, 2020 depreciation compliance filing (“2020 Filing”) by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP). The 2020 Filing was made pursuant to RMP’s depreciation rate reporting system implemented in accordance with paragraph 30 of the settlement stipulation approved on November 7, 2013 in this docket. The 2020 Filing identifies RMP’s plans to retire Cholla Unit 4 as of December 31, 2020 and the filing of a decommissioning cost study for certain coal-fueled resources in Docket No. 18-035-36 on January 16, 2020.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on March 16, 2020. DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the 2020 Filing. DPU states the 2020 Filing complies with the PSC-approved reporting requirements and is consistent with prior years’ filings.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and DPU’s recommendation, the PSC acknowledges RMP’s 2020 Filing as complying with the PSC-approved depreciation reporting requirements.
