2. City is a municipal provider of retail electric service within the municipal boundaries of the City. The municipal offices of Hurricane City are located at 147 North 870 West, Hurricane, UT 84737.

3. The Legislature of the State of Utah passed Senate Bill 180 (the “Bill”) during the 2013 General Session of the Legislature amending Title 54, Chapter 3 of the Utah Code to add a new Section 30 regarding electric service by a public utility to customers located within a municipal boundary. The Bill became law on May 13, 2013.

4. Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-3-31(4)(b)<sup>1</sup> the Company has submitted a request to the City to provide electric service to the Additional Customers(s), City has agreed to allow Rocky Mountain Power to provide electric service to the Additional Customers(s), and the Company and the City have entered into the Agreement for the provision of electric service to the Additional Customer(s), subject to the approval of the Public Service Commission.

5. The Parties have entered into the Agreement, subject to the Commission’s approval, in compliance with Utah Code Ann. §§ 54-3-30 and 54-4-40 to provide terms and conditions for the Company to provide electric service to Additional Customer(s) in accordance with, the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
