I see that Rocky Mountain Power is requesting a rate increase that includes a discriminatory fee on users that produce their own power. That should not be allowed.

Their fees and rates are intended to cover the cost of providing power to customers. Their recent rate increases and any forthcoming should continue to ensure that their costs are covered. However, those costs include expansion due to demand and any user reduction in use or offsetting by alternate generation reduces their need for expansion. Increasing efficiency and setting up alternative production requires a large investment by users and provides general savings in expansion costs. This should be encouraged not fined.
