Dear Public Service Commission,

Please do not grant Rocky Mountain Power's request to charge net metering customers an extra \$4.25 per month for the "privilege" of net metering. I understand that RMP incurs a cost for net metering customers in that they provide a net meter card for the digital meters and probably hire personnel to run the program, HOWEVER, the external costs that the COMPANY inflicts on the people of Utah far outweigh anything that RMP has to pay for customers to net meter. With approximately 82% of Utah's electric power generated by coal, the external health, environmental and economic costs are huge.

If anything, Rocky Mountain Power or the State of Utah should pay a feed-in tariff to those who generate extra grid power, especially during the high demand summer months.
