Dear Utah Public Service Commission:

I have invested in a 3.18 kilowatt photo-voltaic system, at no small expense. I offer for your consideration three points regarding Rocky Mountain Power's proposed additional monthly fee for net-metered photo-voltaic systems like mine:

- 1) I already pay the standard monthly fee to be connected to Rocky Mountain Power.
- 2) I already pay the standard rate per kilowatt hour for any electricity that I use.
- 3) My system feeds electricity into the grid to be used by Rocky Mountain Power's customers in my neighborhood, often during hours of peak usage, and without the usual transmission line losses that come with long-distance transmission.

In light of the first two points, I urge you to deny Rocky Mountain Power's proposed additional fee. In light of the last point, perhaps it would be fair to charge Rocky Mountain Power a fee for their use of my infrastructure.
