Dear Commissioner LeVar,

Rocky Mountain Power must produce an in-depth cost analysis to prove its assertion that solar-equipped homeowners are not paying their fair share of power grid maintenance, before asking the State to impose a "solar tax" on solar homeowners.

Furthermore, Rocky Mountain Power is a free-market business and must expect that its markets will continually change, just as with any other business, including producing what customers want at a competitive price – including power from renewable energy sources at a price comparable to equipping and running residential solar. Its business model has become obsolete and must adapt.

Finally, government should not impose artificial pricing structures on its citizens, but let the competitive market and personal enterprise have their way.

Please keep solar fair in Utah, and deny Rocky Mountain Power's request that the State impose solar use tax on some of its customers.
