I would like to ask that the Public Service Commission to reject Rocky Mountain Power's request for a solar fee on their net metering customers and any increase in the minimum customer bill.

Over and over I have been told to reduce my energy consumption specifically with Rocky Mountain Power's "Wattsmart" program but now Rocky Mountain Power wants to charge a fee which seems to be based on penalizing energy conservation. Electricity rates should be based on usage and the rate structure should encourage users to reduce their energy consumption, especially here in Utah with the Wasatch Front's inversions.

There have been some people who claim to have \$5 electricity bills but they are the exception. My bill has averaged over \$60 for the last four years on equal pay with a 1.8 kw system. Please do not penalize solar users and only raise the minimum bill customers pay after very careful consideration.
