Dear Utah Public Services Commission,

We strongly urge the PSC to **DENY Rocky Mountain Power's request for a monthly fee** (or any extra charge by any power provider) to be levied on utility customers who install solar systems on their property. Instead, Rocky Mountain Power should be rewarding and incentivizing customers who generate their own clean, safe, renewable electricity—which thereby reduces the costly damage caused by RMP's burning dirty coal and other greenhouse-gas-producing sources of energy. Installing clean, safe renewable solar also reduces RMP's need to increase their reliance on harmful, damaging, air-polluting fossil fuels and thereby saves them money. To penalize a customer for becoming more sustainable and self-reliant is immoral.
