Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”) hereby submits for filing its Post-Hearing Brief on Net Metering Facilities Charge (“NMFC”) in Docket No. 13-035-184 (“Docket”). An original and ten (10) copies of this filing will be provided via hand delivery. The Company will also provide electronic versions of this filing to [psc@utah.gov](mailto:psc@utah.gov).

In addition, the Company hereby responds to Sierra Club’s petition (“Petition”) filed on August 6, 2014 in the Docket that included names and other contact information of people allegedly opposing the Company’s NMFC. Sierra Club is an intervenor who was represented by counsel who is well aware of the procedural schedule in this case. Sierra Club’s Petition is inappropriate and woefully late. There is no time for the Company to verify the accuracy of the information contained within the Petition. It is also worth noting that there are several duplicate names within the Petition. At the very least, Sierra Club could have submitted the actual signatures. In addition, nearly all of the “signatures” in the Petition pre-date the NMFC hearing, held on July 28-29, 2014. As such, Sierra Club could have submitted the Petition before the hearing was held.

Perhaps Sierra Club is not used to practicing in jurisdictions where rules and procedure matter and are followed. At hearing, the Commission mentioned that it took the rules under which it operates very seriously. Accordingly, the Company urges the Commission to give the Petition no weight given the inappropriateness and untimeliness of the filing.
