RE: Advice Letter 13-06, Docket No. 13-035-T07: In this filing Rocky Mountain Power proposes to modify Special Conditions 3 for Customers taking service under Schedule 10, Irrigation and Soil Drainage Pumping Service, to provide that unused net metering credits for these Customers expire in October each year, after the end of the irrigation season.

Dear Ms. Meyer:

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff revisions to Schedule No. 10 transmitted with Advice Letter No. 13-06 dated April 1, 2013. In this letter PacifiCorp explains the proposed changes were enabled by the passage of 2013 Utah House Bill 284 – Net Metering Billing Cycles, which was signed by Governor Herbert on March 26, 2013. PacifiCorp requests an effective date of May 1, 2013, for the proposed tariff revisions. The Division of Public Utilities and the Office of Consumer Services have recommended that the Commission approve the revisions to Schedule No. 10.

The Commission notes that while Governor Herbert signed House Bill 284 on March 26, 2013, the effective date of the bill is May 14, 2013.¹ Therefore, the revisions proposed in Advice Letter No. 13-06 are approved by the Commission with an effective date of May 14, 2013.
