INDUSTRIAL POWER SERVICE (5000 KVA AND ABOVE)

Rate Code: **0011**

AVAILABILITY

Available to the Consumers governed by the Power Supply and Electric Service Agreement and subject to the established rules and regulations of Seller.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Three-phase, 60 cycles at Sellers standard voltages, or at other voltages as may be determined by the Power Supply and Electric Service Agreement.

MONTHLY CHARGE

The Monthly Charge for electric service shall consist of; (1) an allocation of Tier 1 and Tier 2 power costs, metered at Consumers Billing Meter corrected for losses, plus (2) any additional power supply charges or credits and/or transmission charges or credits incurred by Seller associated with providing electric service to Consumer, plus (3) a Sellers Monthly Delivery Charge component, plus (4) a charge for Unused Contract Demand.

SELLERS MONTHLY DELIVERY CHARGE

1. Monthly Delivery Charge: \$39,183.00

SELLERS UNUSED CONTRACT DEMAND CHARGE

Unused Contract Demand is defined by Seller and Consumers Power Supply and Electric Supply Agreement.

Sellers Unused Contract Demand charge: \$0.32 per kW

LOSS CORRECTION

Seller shall correct the Consumer's measured demand and energy by 2 percent to correct for system losses.

DETERMINATION OF MONTHLY MEASURED DEMAND

The monthly measured demand shall be the measured average kW supplied during the 60 minute period of maximum use as determined at the Consumers billing meter coincident with the Sellers power supply charge for demand. and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

Demand charges shall be adjusted for power factor identical to any adjustment made by Sellers power supplier. Power factor shall be determined at the Billing Meter.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, due and payable as described in the Power Supply/Line Extension Agreement.
