I am writing to respectfully request the Commission to conduct a full and fair assessment of the impacts of displacing fossil fuels with solar and wind in the generation of electricity. I am confident that when all of the costs (including the cost of pollution, including the impact of greenhouse gases and human health detriments) and benefits (cleaner air, less haze, better health, etc.) are fully considered, it will be clear that transitioning to renewables is the best approach. As an interim step, it seems to me that converting Rocky Mountain Power coal burning plants to natural gas would be a smart move and would allow faster introduction to wind and solar production facilities.
