As an intervening party to the docket, UCARE has no problem with the order of witnesses specified in today's "Second Prehearing Notice" for Docket No. 14-035-114.

However, I do have other questions about the format of next week's PSC hearing. I wonder what time has been allocated for intervening parties that have not pre-filed written testimony but wish to present evidence. While UCARE has submitted comments, proposals, and a workgroup session presentation to the docket, we have not submitted direct or rebuttal testimony.
