Hello Mr. Dalton,

Having recently placed rooftop solar on my house, you can bet I've got an interest in RMP's attempt to shut it down. It's clearly punitive. Any access fees or fees for grid maintenance should be (at most) shared among all ratepayers. Instead RMP is targeting rooftop solar, claiming we're somehow not doing our share. If that were true, they'd be equally angry at people who install insulation or turn out the lights when then leave the room. No, they really just want to shut down the solar industry.

By most estimates, I'll be 80 years old when my investment pays off. My wife and I did this mainly because it's the right thing to do. By placing our money where our ethics are, perhaps we can help the industry to realize efficiencies that bring solar within the range of more modest incomes. There are far more potential jobs in this industry than there ever were in coal—decent jobs with good pay and greater safety. Coal will die—the rest of the world is moving in that direction—so the transparent efforts of RMP will only prolong the changeover—placing Utah last when it could be first.

Rocky Mountain Power has a direct interest in coal mining and appears ready to do anything to protect their monopoly and their profits. They have many influential friends in Utah government, so it will take some courage to stand up to them. I hope the PSC has that kind of courage. Just think about it the next time you're choking in a coal-powered inversion.

I am writing this letter to ask that the commission kindly deny Schedule 136 and its related Schedule 5 tariff.

This summer, my electricity was shut off 5 times for what the company called "unexpected failures" in its power grid. Some of these outages lasted up to 12 hours. Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP's) frequent, non-weather related failures truly impact their customers' lives and should be of great public concern. RMP enjoys a monopoly as a power supplier in Utah. These outages reflect how the lack of economic pressure to serve its customers is leading to a neglect of its power grid. Upgrades are needed. Now, RMP wants to burden a small group of rooftop solar customers with an unfair and unequal tariff to bankroll these upgrades. Disproportionate rate increases are an obvious and greedy tactic to shift responsibility from their aging infrastructure and an attempt to stifle competition from the solar industry. Alternative sources of providing energy should be encouraged, not demonized, by Utah. For RMP, it's more about protecting their profits than providing good service to their customers. Please speak for all of RMP's customers by stopping the tariff. Thanks.
