**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF SALT
LAKE COUNTY**

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-207 and Utah Admin. R746-100-7, Salt Lake County ("County") hereby petitions the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") for leave to intervene in the above-entitled matter. In support of this petition, County states as follows:

1. The County is a local government in Utah serving the interests of a large number of citizens who are customers of Rocky Mountain Power d/b/a PacifiCorp ("Rocky Mountain Power"). The County owns and operates over 150 facilities throughout Salt Lake County and is committed to utilizing energy efficiency and renewable energy technologies at these facilities and future facilities. In addition, the County offers a number of resources to assist low-to moderate-income families create healthy, safe and energy efficient homes. One such program, the Idea House transforms the most run-down, hazardous, and inefficient properties into healthy

and safe homes in which the community can be proud. Solar technologies have been used in this program in the past.

2. The County, through the Salt Lake County Health Department, is responsible for promoting and protecting community and environmental health. It works to protect and improve the well-being of all county residents by preventing disease, illness, and injury and by impacting social, economic, and environmental factors fundamental to excellent health.

3. The County is a customer of Rocky Mountain Power and consumes a large amount of electricity across many sites. The County has an interest in developing new renewable energy systems through net metering arrangements. The cost-benefit methods and values set through this docket have the potential to impact the County's existing renewable energy systems and ability to develop new projects.

4. The County has a significant interest in the above-captioned matter for the reasons set forth herein. As such, the County's legal rights and interests may be substantially affected by the outcome of this docket.

5. The County's interests are not adequately represented by another party in this proceeding.

6. The County's intervention and participation in this matter will not materially impair the prompt and orderly conduct of these proceedings.
