Docket No. 14-035-114, In the Matter of the Investigation of the Costs and Benefits of PacifiCorp's Net Metering Program.

Dear Mr. Widerburg:

I reviewed my direct testimony filed on behalf of the Office of Consumer Services on June 8, 2017 in the Matter of the Investigation of the Costs and Benefits of PacifiCorp's Net Metering Program., Docket No. 14-035-114. I identified the two errors that need to be corrected.

First, in my direct testimony workpapers under the tab "Customer Charge Calculation", the value in cell N16 should be 57,450, not 54,450. This typographical error was also included in my direct testimony. Therefore, on page 7, lines 184, 187, and 190, \$54,450, should be \$57,450. This correction increases the value in cell F27 in tab "Customer Charge Calculation" in my workpaper from 8.42 to 8.48, which is consistent with what I stated in my direct testimony.

Second, in my direct testimony workpapers, FERC Subaccount 903.2 was inadvertently omitted from the FERC Account 903 subaccount percentage calculation. I re-ran the calculations based on the total percentage breakdown of FERC account 903, including FERC subaccount 903.2. This correction increases the value in cell F27 in tab "Customer Charge Calculation" in my workpaper from 8.48 to 8.50.

Neither of these corrections change my residential net metering customer charge recommendation. Attached to this memo are replacement copies of my direct testimony, in
