Pursuant to R746-1-301, the Office of Consumer Services and Intervenors Vivint Solar, Utah Clean Energy, HEAL Utah, Utah Solar Energy Association, Vote Solar, Energy Freedom Coalition of America, SunRun, Sierra Club, Summit County, and Salt Lake City Corporation (collectively, the "Joint Movants") submit this Joint Motion to Amend the Utah Public Service Commission (the "Commission")'s November 18, 2016 Scheduling Order in this proceeding, and stay the hearing scheduled to begin on August 14, 2017, until the week of September 18, 2017, while the Parties to the proceeding continue settlement discussions. The Joint Movants make this request now based on significant progress that has occurred in settlement discussions recently and the expectation that a stay of the hearing will facilitate a negotiated resolution of the proceeding.

Due to the short time frame between the filing of this motion and the scheduled start of the hearing on August 14, and the interest in resolving travel and logistical issues, the Joint Movants respectfully request that the Commission shorten any time for response, grant expedited consideration of this motion, and issue a decision today, August 10, 2017.

WHEREFORE, the Joint Movants respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order amending the November 18, 2016 Scheduling Order, staying the hearing scheduled to begin on August 14, 2107, rescheduling the hearing for the week of September 18, 2017.
