Please consider those of us that are either getting or have solar as an alternative power source. That we not be unfairly taxed or charged for taking the initiative to reduce emissions and global warming.

The proposed changes that Rocky Mountain Power have been submitted to you are unfair to those of us who have or will get alternative power. The following items are unfair and should be denied:

- \$15/month service charge (compared to \$6/month)
- \$9.02 per kilowatt demand charge for "on-peak" demand: May-September is 3:00-8:00 pm, M-F (excluding holidays); October-April is 8:00-10:00 am and 3:00-8:00 pm
 - 0,04 \$ per kilowatt hour for electricity (compared to an average of 10.7 cents)
