Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-1 and the Rules of the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”), Western Resource Advocates (“WRA”) submits for filing the enclosed *Testimony in Opposition to Stipulation*. The purpose of this filing is to oppose relevant portions of the *Settlement Stipulation* (“Stipulation”) filed by the Signatories on August 28, 2017.¹ The Commission has scheduled a hearing on the Stipulation to begin September 18, 2017. While WRA opposes the Stipulation in its current form, in order to minimize time and expense for other parties in this proceeding, WRA will waive cross-examination on all testimony filed to date. Further, while WRA will make its expert witness, Steven S. Michel, available for the September 18 hearing, WRA is also willing to stipulate Mr. Michel’s pre-filed testimony (rebuttal, surrebuttal and opposition) into the evidentiary record if no cross-examination is requested.
