The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed the December 14, 2017 filing by PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power ("PacifiCorp"), proposing changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 136, Transition Program for Customer Generators ("Schedule 136"). The proposed changes to Sheet No. 136.6 add language related to meter aggregation and make minor administrative changes. According to PacifiCorp, pursuant to the PSC's November 14, 2017 order in this docket, it worked with interested settlement parties to propose language that provides for aggregation of meters in the new net metering transition program. PacifiCorp requests an effective date of January 16, 2018 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the December 19, 2017 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU"). The DPU states it participated in PacifiCorp's discussions on meter aggregation and supports the proposed tariff language, which accurately reflects the discussions. Therefore the DPU recommends the PSC approve the proposed changes to Sheet No. 136.6 as filed. No other comments were received.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the DPU's recommendation, the proposed revisions to Sheet No. 136.6 of Schedule 136 are approved as filed, effective January 16, 2018.
