The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed the April 3, 2018 filing by PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power ("PacifiCorp"), proposing changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 135, Net Metering Service ("Schedule 135"), effective May 2, 2018. Consistent with 2018 Utah Senate Bill 141¹, and pursuant to the February 7, 2018 letter from the PSC, PacifiCorp proposes adding language to Sheet No. 135.1 identifying the December 31, 2035 termination date of Schedule 135.

The PSC also reviewed the April 23, 2018 Action Request Response filed by the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU"). Based on its review of PacifiCorp's April 3, 2018 filing, the DPU concludes PacifiCorp's proposed changes to Schedule 135 comply with the PSC's order and recommends the PSC approve them. No other comments were received.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the DPU's recommendation, the proposed revisions to Sheet No. 135.1 of Schedule 135 are approved as filed, effective May 2, 2018.

¹ In the 2018 Utah Legislative Session, Senate Bill 141, Electric Energy Amendments, was passed by the legislature which repeals Title 54, Chapter 15, Net Metering of Electricity, on January 1, 2036.
