Based on discovery requests received from the parties in these dockets, it has come to the attention of Rocky Mountain Power that the line loss factors included in the power purchase agreements filed for approval in the above-captioned dockets are incorrect. Accordingly, Rocky Mountain Power hereby files amended power purchase agreements for approval that contain the correct line loss factor. In addition, the parties have made a second correction that properly accounts for the daylight savings time period as adopted under Section 110 of the U.S. Energy Policy Act of 2005. No other changes have been made to the agreements, and Rocky Mountain Power requests that the amended agreements replace the previously filed agreements in their entirety.
