Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-207 and Utah Admin. Code R746-100-7, Ecoplexus, Inc., Inc. respectfully petitions the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) for leave to intervene in this docket regarding the review of Electric Service Schedule No. 38, Qualifying Facilities Procedures, and other related procedural issues. In support of this petition, Ecoplexus, Inc. states as follows:

1. Ecoplexus, Inc. develops commercial and utility scale solar projects. Ecoplexus, Inc. is a leader in the development, design, engineering, construction, and financing of solar energy systems for the non-profit, commercial, municipal, and utility markets. The company provides a

full set of professional services covering the entire process for a solar energy facility. It is currently in the process of developing solar PURPA projects in Utah.

2. As a developer of PURPA solar projects in Utah, Ecoplexus, Inc.'s legal rights and interests may be substantially affected by this proceeding.

3. Ecoplexus, Inc. has not fully determined specific positions it will take or the relief it will seek. Ecoplexus, Inc. seeks to intervene for purposes of protecting its interests as they arise.

4. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will not be materially impaired by allowing Ecoplexus, Inc. to intervene. Intervention by Ecoplexus, Inc. will not unduly broaden the issues, delay the proceeding, or materially impair the orderly conduct of the proceeding.
