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Utah Clean Energy respectfully requests that the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) admit Utah Clean Energy’s late-filed Exhibit 3.2 in the above-captioned proceeding to the official record of the docket.

At the time Utah Clean Energy filed the surrebuttal testimony of Ken Dragoon (on June 11, 2015) Utah Clean Energy was awaiting the response of Rocky Mountain Power to a follow-up data request (set four) that we submitted after reviewing responses to our second and third sets of discovery requests regarding transmission constraints and their impact on the Company’s capacity contribution calculations. Ken Dragoon referenced this outstanding discovery request in his surrebuttal testimony at line 101, note 2.

On June 17, 2015, Rocky Mountain Power provided Utah Clean Energy with the responses to this fourth set of discovery requests. Having reviewed these responses, Utah Clean Energy now proposes to include the Company’s response to UCE request 4.3, along with the question leading to the response, as a late-filed exhibit accompanying the surrebuttal testimony of Ken Dragoon, to be marked as UCE Exhibit 3.2, with specific reference to lines 93-101 and footnotes 1 and 2.

Given that the hearing in this proceeding has been canceled, Utah Clean Energy now offers Exhibit 3.2, filed on June 18 in this docket, as evidence and asks that the Commission admit it to the official record of this proceeding.
