Rocky Mountain Power, dba PacifiCorp (“PacifiCorp”), filed a request on February 7, 2014, for approval of an agreement with Monroe City, Utah (“City”), whereby PacifiCorp agrees to allow the City to provide electric service to certain additional customer(s) located outside the City’s municipal boundaries and located within PacifiCorp’s certificated service territory (“Agreement”). The Agreement is in the form of the first amendment to PacifiCorp’s existing agreement with the City, dated September 27, 2013, and approved by the Commission in Docket No. 13-035-162. Any interested party may submit comments on PacifiCorp’s request on or before Wednesday, March 12, 2014, and reply comments may be submitted on or before Friday, March 28, 2014.
