Dear Mr. Larsen:

On May 16, 2014, PacifiCorp, dba as Rocky Mountain Power in Utah, filed its Demand-Side Management 2013 Energy Efficiency and Peak Load Reduction Report ("2013 DSM Report"). PacifiCorp filed the 2013 DSM Report to comply with the Commission's Order in Docket No. 09-035-27 requiring PacifiCorp to file an annual DSM report by March 31st showing results for the prior year. In Docket No. 12-035-116, the Commission approved permanently moving the required filing date to May 1st. However, for the 2013 DSM Report, PacifiCorp requested, and received approval from the Commission, for a one time filing extension of May 16, 2014.

The Commission received comments on the 2013 DSM Report from the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") on June 13, 2014, and from the Office of Consumer Services ("Office") on June 16, 2014.

Based on its review of the 2013 DSM Report, the Division observes the 2013 DSM Report shows the DSM portfolio passes the five cost-effectiveness tests and recommends the Commission acknowledge PacifiCorp's 2013 DSM Annual Report as complying with Commission reporting requirements. The Office states it reviewed the 2013 DSM Report and the attached appendices. The Office agrees the DSM portfolio is cost effective. Based on its review of Commission reporting requirements and the information provided by PacifiCorp to fulfill those requirements, the Office recommends the Commission acknowledge the 2013 DSM Annual Report.
