REPLY COMMENTS OF DEVELOPERS


Pursuant to the Scheduling Order in these dockets, Enterprise Solar, LLC, Escalante Solar I, LLC, Escalante Solar II, LLC and Escalante Solar III, LLC (the “Developers”) hereby provide the following comments in reply to comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) and the Office of Consumer Services (“Office”) in these dockets.

The Developers are developing the solar projects at issue in these dockets, and are the Sellers under the Power Purchase Agreements (“PPAs”) filed for approval. The Developers appreciate the comments filed by the Division and Office supporting Commission approval of the PPAs.¹ The Developers believe that the Applications of Rocky Mountain Power and the Comments of the Division and the Office in these dockets demonstrate clearly that all four PPAs are compliant with all applicable Commission orders and in the public interest.

Given that all parties to these proceeding support approval of the PPAs, the Developers respectfully request that the Commission promptly approve the PPAs so that they can continue their development efforts in order to bring significant new solar resources to this State.
