ISSUED: July 31, 2014

On July 18, 2014, the Commission issued a scheduling order and notice of hearings in these dockets (“Scheduling Order”). On July 31, 2014, Enterprise Solar, LLC, Escalante Solar I, LLC, Escalante Solar II, LLC, and Escalante Solar III, LLC (“Developers”) filed a motion for an amendment to the Scheduling Order in these dockets. Specifically, the Developers request the hearing date in each of these dockets be moved from Tuesday, October 7, 2014, at 9:00 a.m., to Thursday, October 2, 2014, at 2:00 p.m., in order to accommodate a scheduling conflict of counsel for the Developers.

Counsel for the Developers represents he has confirmed that all of the other parties to these dockets, Rocky Mountain Power, the Division of Public Utilities and the Office

of Consumer Services, have no objection to Developers' motion or the requested hearing date. Based on the foregoing, and for other good cause appearing, the dates of the Scheduling Order are modified as follows:

DISCOVERY AND FILINGS

All parties shall reply to requests for data or discovery within fourteen calendar days of receipt until September 4, 2014, and shall make best efforts to reply to requests for data or discovery within seven calendar days of receipt thereafter. Parties shall serve copies of all filings on other parties by electronic mail at or before the time an electronic copy of the document is required to be filed with the Commission. In the event a document filed with the Commission or produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party filing the document shall file an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) with the Commission by hand delivery and shall serve an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) on each applicable party by hand delivery if the party being served is

in the same metropolitan area as the serving party, or by overnight courier if the party being served is located in a different metropolitan area from the serving party.

NOTICE OF HEARINGS

Hearings in these dockets will be conducted consecutively by the Commission's designated Presiding Officer on **Thursday, October 2, 2014, beginning at 2:00 p.m. (MDT)**. The hearings will be held in the **Fourth Floor Hearing Room 403, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah**. All parties must have their witnesses in attendance and prepared to testify.

Participants attending by telephone should then call the Public Service Commission at the same number listed above five minutes prior to the hearings to ensure participation.
