ISSUED: May 16, 2014

On April 25, 2014, Rocky Mountain Power, dba PacifiCorp (“PacifiCorp”) filed Advice No. 14-02, requesting approval of Electric Service Schedule No. 32, Service from Renewable Energy Facilities (“Schedule 32”). PacifiCorp’s proposed Schedule 32 provides prices for services required to facilitate a renewable energy contract. Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code § R746-405-2.E., “[u]tility tariffs may not increase rates, charges or conditions, change classifications which result in increases in rates and charges or make changes which result in lesser service or more restrictive conditions at the same rate or charge, unless a showing has been made before and a finding has been made by the Commission that the increases or changes are justified.” Although Schedule 32 was submitted as an advice letter filing, the Commission must hold a hearing and make a finding that the rates proposed in Schedule 32 are just, reasonable and in the public interest prior to making the proposed tariff effective. As such, the 30-day effective period under Utah Admin. Code § R746-405-2.E.2. is inapplicable and therefore suspension of Schedule 32 is unnecessary. *See also* Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(5)(c).

On May 14, 2014, the Commission held a scheduling conference in this docket. In accordance with the discussion at the conference, the parties have agreed to the following schedule.
