AMENDED NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD

On May 7, 2014, Rocky Mountain Power, dba PacifiCorp ("PacifiCorp") filed Advice No. 14-03, proposing revisions to PacifiCorp Schedule 140, Non-Residential Energy Efficiency, with a requested effective date of June 6, 2014. The Commission issued a notice of filing and comment period on May 7, 2014, allowing for comments and reply comments on May 22 and May 29, 2014, respectively.

On May 15, 2014, PacifiCorp filed supplemental materials regarding its tariff filing and on May 16, 2014, PacifiCorp filed a request to change the effective date of the proposed tariff revisions from June 6, 2014, to July 1, 2014.

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") filed a memorandum on May 19, 2014, requesting an extension of its action request response date to June 5, 2014. According to the Division, additional time is necessary for the Division to review the supplemental materials filed by PacifiCorp. Based on the Division's request and for good cause appearing, the initial comment deadline of May 22, 2014, is extended to **Thursday, June 5, 2014**, and the reply comment deadline of May 29, 2014, is extended to **Monday June 16, 2014**.

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ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

The schedule for this docket now provides for reply deadlines beyond the 30-day tariff review period specified by Utah Admin. Code § R746-405-2.E.2. As such, pursuant to Utah Admin. Code § R746-405-2.E.4.a, the Commission suspends PacifiCorp's proposed tariff changes pending further action by the Commission.

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Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the written order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
