ISSUED: June 5, 2014

On May 7, 2014, Rocky Mountain Power, dba PacifiCorp (“PacifiCorp”) filed Advice No. 14-04, proposing revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 37, Avoided Cost Purchases From Qualifying Facilities. On June 3, 2014, the Commission held a scheduling conference in this docket. In accordance with the discussion at the conference, the parties have agreed to the following schedule.

COMMENTS REGARDING INTERIM APPLICATION OF 25,000 KW CAP

Schedule 37 states “A cumulative cap of 25,000 kW shall apply to new resources contracted under this schedule.” According to the parties present at the June 3, 2014, scheduling conference, PacifiCorp is close to reaching the 25,000 kW cap. Parties at the scheduling conference posed the question of the whether Schedule 37 pricing would be available to Qualifying Facilities after the time the 25,000 kW cap is met but prior to the Commission’s decision regarding PacifiCorp’s proposed revisions to Schedule 37. Based on the schedule provided in this scheduling order, a Commission decision on PacifiCorp’s proposed revisions would occur no earlier than Tuesday, September 16, 2014.

The Commission invites interested parties to submit comments on or before **Thursday, June 12, 2014**, regarding the application of the 25,000 kW cumulative cap under Schedule 37 during the time period between the time the 25,000 kW cap is met but prior to the Commission’s decision regarding PacifiCorp’s proposed revisions to Schedule 37. Reply comments regarding this topic may be submitted on or before **Thursday, June 19, 2014**.

DISCOVERY

Discovery turn-around times are fourteen calendar days until August 12, 2014, and seven calendar days thereafter. Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail.
