NOTICE OF AMENDED COMMENT PERIOD

On July 9, 2014, Rocky Mountain Power, dba PacifiCorp (“PacifiCorp”) filed Advice No. 14-07, proposing revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 111, Home Energy Savings Incentive Program (“Schedule 111”). That same day, the Commission issued a notice of filing and comment period, providing for comments from interested parties on PacifiCorp’s proposed tariff revisions on or before Friday, July 25, 2014, and reply comments on or before Friday, August 1, 2014.

On July 17, 2014, the Office of Consumer Services (“Office”) filed a request to amend the initial comment period from July 25 to August 15, 2014, and the reply comment period from August 1 to August 25, 2014. The Office indicates PacifiCorp’s filing represents broad changes to Schedule 111, requiring additional time to thoroughly review the proposed revisions and submit and review discovery. The Office further represents it has contacted the Division of Public Utilities and PacifiCorp and neither party objects to the extension request.

Based on the Office’s request and for good cause appearing, the initial comment deadline of July 25, 2014, is extended to **Friday, August 15, 2014**, and the reply comment deadline of August 1, 2014, is extended to **Monday August 25, 2014**.

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ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

The schedule for this docket now provides for reply deadlines beyond the 30-day tariff review period specified by Utah Admin. Code § R746-405-2.E.2. As such, pursuant to Utah Admin. Code § R746-405-2.E.4, the Commission suspends PacifiCorp's proposed tariff changes pending further action by the Commission.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the written order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
