

Energy Policy

Everyone globally must cease all operations that utilize coal or any derivative thereof. These operations will be replaced by those that use less than 50% natural gas from free flowing sources; and more than 50% clean, healthy, and safe sources that do not emit carbon in any form! Nuclear is not allowed unless it can be proven and demonstrated in advance of use that the facility is completely fail safe under all conditions.

Fines will be imposed immediately until operations cease. These fines will be based on the amount of coal used and cannot be passed on to consumers of products produced using coal.

It must be that hydroelectric power be developed and used from all existing dams and low head future sources. Wind, solar, and geothermal facilities should be given high priority for development. Other clean sources such as wave, tidal motion, and hydrogen should be included.

The Pickens Plan shall be used for transportation to convert trucks, trains, and ships to free flowing natural gas, electric, and other clean energy. Develop new energy grid with underground transmission lines with minimum footprint. Superconducting lines should be developed and included.
