On November 2, 2015, PacifiCorp dba Rocky Mountain Power ("PacifiCorp") filed its Annual Demand-Side Management Deferred Account and Forecast Report for 2016 ("Report") with the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission"). Comments on the Report were filed by the Utah Division of Public Utilities ("Division") and the Utah Association of Energy Users ("UAE"), and PacifiCorp filed reply comments in response to UAE's comments.

The Division concludes the Report is in compliance with previous Commission Orders in Docket Nos. 09-035-T08, 10-035-57 and 13-035-136 and recommends the Commission acknowledge the Report. UAE does not object to the Commission acknowledging RMP's Report but expresses concerns about the DSM surcharge level as well as cost-overruns it perceives in certain DSM programs.

The Commission reviewed the Report, UAE's and the Division's comments and recommendations, PacifiCorp's reply comments and we acknowledge that the Report complies with the Commission's reporting requirements. In addition, if any party believes that further investigation into DSM programs is warranted, a request for agency action is an appropriate means for initiating such an inquiry.
