Dear Mr. Larsen:

On May 29, 2015, the Commission received PacifiCorp's Affiliated Interest Report for the Year Ended December 31, 2014, ("Report"), filed in accordance with MidAmerican Holdings Company Transaction Commitment #8 approved in Docket No. 05-035-54.

On November 3, 2015, the Commission received an action request response from the Division of Public Utilities ("Division"), providing its review of the Report and recommendations. Based on its review, the Division concludes: 1) Active affiliated interest relationships exist between PacifiCorp and the reported entities; 2) the appropriate affiliate transactions information was provided to the Division; and 3) the activity between the affiliates as reported in the filing does not appear to be adverse to the public interest. The Division recommends the Commission accept the Report.

The Division also makes a recommendation for PacifiCorp's Affiliated Interest Report for the year ending 2015. The Division recommends PacifiCorp include an industry pricing comparison to provide assurance to the Commission that the prices charged by HomeServices of America, Inc. are within an acceptable range of those charged in the industry.

Based on the Division's review, the Commission accepts the Report as filed. In order to provide the assurance noted by the Division, the Commission directs PacifiCorp to include an industry pricing comparison as recommended by the Division in its next annual affiliated interest report.
