2015 Smart Grid Monitoring Report

Pursuant to the recommendation and comments of the Division on Public Utilities (“DPU”) dated September 16, 2015 in the above referenced docket, the Company herein provides supplemental information responding to deficiencies referenced by the DPU in the Company’s Revised 2015 Smart Grid Annual Report filed on August 17, 2015.

The information identified below is provided based on discussions with the DPU and the OCS and is expected to comply with the requirements of the 2015 Smart Grid Annual Report.

Requirement 6 – An Explanation of the interaction of smart grid, possible rate structures, and consumer behavior. (Exhibit 1)

Requirement 8 – A discussion of alignment of the demand-side resource performance standards approved by the Commission with smart grid analysis. Exhibit (1)

Requirement 9 – A discussion of microgrids. (Exhibit 1)

Attachment A – Previously filed confidential Attachment A (including formulas used in the modeling). (Confidential Exhibit 2)

Confidential Exhibit 2 contains information that is commercially sensitive to Rocky Mountain Power and is confidential. Accordingly, Rocky Mountain Power is filing the confidential documents, under seal pursuant to R746-100-16, and requests that the Commission require any party who wishes to view these documents execute a Confidential Information Certificate. A Confidential CD containing the confidential material is also being provided with this filing.

In its comments in this docket the Division and the Office recommended discontinuance of the required report “until such time as there are clear indications that the smart grid landscape has changed in a significant way.” The Company concurs with this recommendation, and suggests

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that as circumstances change, the reestablishment of smart grid reporting may be initiated by a petition to the Commission of any interested party.
