ISSUED: March 12, 2015

On February 16, 2015,¹ PacifiCorp, dba Rocky Mountain Power (“PacifiCorp”) filed with the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) Advice Letter 15-01, proposing tariff revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 11 – Street Lighting Company-Owned System and Electric Service Schedule No. 12 – Street Lighting Customer-Owned System. Among other revisions, PacifiCorp’s filing introduces Light-Emitting Diode (“LED”) as an alternative for currently offered lighting with associated flat rate pricing for the new LED option.

Pursuant to the Commission’s February 18, 2015, Notice of Filing and Comment Period, the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) filed an action request response on March 4, 2015, recommending approval of PacifiCorp’s proposed tariff revisions.
