The Commission reviewed the proposed tariff sheet revisions transmitted with your Advice Letter No. 15-05, dated March 30, 2015, in Docket No. 15-035-T04 entitled above and the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") and the Office of Consumer Services ("Office") on April 13 and 14, 2015, respectively. The Division's comments recommended approval of the proposed revisions whereas the Office recommended approval but expressed concerns and recommended adjustments to tariff sheet 140.2.

On April 16, 2015, the Commission issued an Amended Notice of Comment Period in this docket, allowing for reply comments. In response, Rocky Mountain Power filed reply comments on April 24, 2015, that include revisions to tariff sheet 140.2 addressing the Office's comments ("April 24<sup>th</sup> Tariff Revisions"). Rocky Mountain Power represents that it reviewed and discussed the April 24<sup>th</sup> Tariff Revisions with the Office and the Division and both agree the revisions address the Office's concerns.

Based on the recommendation of the Division and the Office, the representations of Rocky Mountain Power, and lack of opposition by any other party, the Commission approves the proposed tariff sheet revisions as filed on March 30, 2015, and as further revised on April 24, 2015, with an effective date of May 15, 2015.
