Re: 15-035-T05 – Replacement Tariff Sheets - In the Matter of Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Revisions to Various Schedules.

RECOMANDATION (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) recommends that the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approve Rocky Mountain Power’s (“Company”) Replacement Tariff Sheets in the above captioned Docket filed with the Commission on May 19, 2015.

ISSUE

In compliance with the Division’s May 13, 2015 recommendation to add clarifying language to its proposed Schedule 80, on May 19, 2015, the Company filed with the Commission its proposed replacement sheets. This filing also contains a corrected Sheet No. 32.6. The Company is requesting an effective date of April 28, 2015. On May 13, 2015, the Commission issued an

Action Request for the Division to investigate the Company's filing and to report back by May 26, 2015. This memorandum is in response to the Commission's Action Request.

DISCUSSION

In response to the Commission's Action Request regarding the Company's proposed revisions to various schedules and the proposed Schedule 80, on May 13, 2015, the Division provided its memorandum to the Commission recommending that the Company add clarifying language to its proposed new Schedule 80. Specifically, the Division suggested the following language: *The X's in each column indicate that the Schedule is subject to the rate adjustments set forth in tariff schedules 91, 94, 98, 193, and 195.*

In compliance with this Division recommendation, the Company filed its replacement sheet to Schedule 80. The Division reviewed this replacement sheet and verified that it contains the required clarifying language. Furthermore, the Company provided corrected Sheet No. 32.6 which appropriately ties Schedule 32 to the new Schedule 80. The Division concludes that the Company's proposed replacement sheets are in compliance with the Commission's directions and the Division's recommendations and proposes that the Commission approve them.

CONCLUSION

The Division has reviewed the proposed replacement sheets and recommends the Commission to approve the Company's replacement sheets effective April 28, 2015.
