Dear Mr. Widerburg,

The Board of Directors of Moon Lake Electric held public hearings regarding the proposed rate increase on tariff rates. A meeting was held in Rangely Colorado on March 8, 2016, with one member attending, and in Roosevelt Utah on March 9, 2016, with fifteen members in attendance.

After consideration of comments received, the Board of Directors voted on March 9, 2016 in favor of the rate increase as proposed. The increase will take effect on the bills mailed out beginning May 1, 2016, and will include April usage in most cases.

Due to not raising tariff rates for approximately 33 years, the percentage adjustment is quite high, 24.9% for the Residential class, and 16.4% for all classes combined. We feel the rates are still affordable considering after the increase they are projected to be at \$.078 per kWh or less for all classes.
