Pursuant to the Order issued by the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") on January 15, 2013 in Docket No. 12-035-116, the Company must file its Demand Side Management Annual Energy Efficiency and Peak Load Reduction Report ("DSM Annual Report") by May 1 annually.

Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") respectfully requests a one-time, 3-week extension for the 2015 DSM Annual Report, to be due May 23, 2016. The necessity of the extension is due to project data reconciliation issues with Company and vendor data. The 3-week extension period will be enough time for the Company to finalize the reconciliation data.
