With the filing of the Stipulation and Partial Settlement Agreement addressing many of the issues in this proceeding and in light of refinements that the Office has made in its position on remaining issues set for hearing, as more specifically outlined in the Office's surrebuttal testimony filed, we are letting Parties know that the Office has determined that it won't be calling Mr. James W. Daniel as a witness in the upcoming hearing, nor will the Office move to have Mr. Daniel's pre-filed, pre-hearing testimony submitted into evidence under Rule 746-1-401 of the PSC Administrative Procedures Rule.

With respect to Mr. Jacob Thomas, the Office is planning to move his pre-filed, pre-hearing testimony into evidence at the upcoming hearing. However, because the issues addressed by Mr. Thomas have been settled, the Office proposes to make Mr. Thomas available as a witness via telephone conferencing for possible cross-examination or to response to Commissioner questions at next week's hearing.

Please let me know by close of business tomorrow, Thursday, May 18, 2017, if you have problems with the approach we are proposing for Mr. Thomas.
