The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the June 6, 2017 compliance filing by PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), updating the proposed Electric Service Regulation No. 13, Sustainable Transportation and Energy Program (STEP) Commercial Line Extension Pilot Program (Regulation 13). Pursuant to the PSC's May 24, 2017 order in this docket, the proposed changes to Sheet No. 13R.1 revise the Provisions of Service section consistent with PacifiCorp's March 28, 2017 rebuttal testimony filed in this docket. The proposed revisions also include minor administrative changes and an effective date of May 24, 2017.

The PSC also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) June 13, 2017 action request response. The DPU concluded PacifiCorp's proposed changes to Regulation 13 accurately implement the PSC's May 24, 2017 order and recommends the PSC approve them as filed.

Based on the PSC's review of PacifiCorp's filing and the DPU's recommendation, the proposed changes to Sheet No. 13R.1 of Regulation 13 are approved as filed, effective May 24, 2017.
