Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed the March 5, 2019 compliance filing made by PacifiCorp, revising Regulation 13, Sheet No. 13R.1 to reflect a \$250,000 incentive limit, and to clarify the amount of the developer's advance in three instances. The filing also included administrative revision to Index Sheet No. D and was made pursuant to the PSC's February 6, 2019 order in this docket.

Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405-2(D), PacifiCorp states that the proposed tariff sheets do not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule.

Based on the PSC's review of PacifiCorp's filing, the updated Regulation 13, Sheet No. 13R.1 and Index Sheet No. D are approved as filed, effective February 11, 2019.
