The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) August 28, 2019 confidential filing ("Filing") of the approved building permit issued by the City of Herriman for the STEP Battery Demand Response Project ("Battery DR Project"). The Filing was made pursuant to the PSC's June 28, 2019 Report and Order ("Order") issued in this docket. The PSC also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) action request response filed on September 24, 2019.

The DPU concludes the Filing complies in part with the Order. The DPU explains the Order requires RMP to provide a copy of the building permit and to add indemnification language to its contract with the developer of the Battery DR Project. According to the DPU, RMP is working with the developer on the indemnification language and will provide it in the near future. Therefore the DPU recommends the PSC conditionally acknowledge the Filing.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges RMP's filing of the City of Herriman's approved building permit for the Battery DR Project.
