The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) December 23, 2021 compliance filing ("Filing").<sup>1</sup> The Filing includes the Electric Vehicle Time of Use Report ("Report") submitted in accordance with paragraph 13 of the Stipulation and Partial Settlement Agreement ("Settlement") approved by the PSC's June 28, 2017 Phase Three Report and Order in this docket. RMP states the Report reflects the minimum reporting requirements enumerated in Exhibit D attached to the Settlement, titled "EV TOU Pilot Report Requirements" ("Report Requirements").

The PSC also reviewed the January 12, 2022 comments submitted by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) recommending the PSC acknowledge the Filing as meeting the Report Requirements. DPU additionally comments that RMP's Report provides beneficial information to help advance electric vehicle time of use rate design.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges that the Filing complies with the EV TOU Pilot Report Requirements.
