#### ORDER OF DISMISSAL

#### ISSUED: February 3, 2017

On September 27, 2016, Blyncsy, Inc. (Blyncsy) filed with the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) a formal complaint against Rocky Mountain Power, a public utility. On October 27, 2017, Rocky Mountain Power answered the complaint and filed a motion to dismiss it. Thereafter, the PSC held a scheduling conference with the parties and, on December 2, 2016, issued a scheduling order setting deadlines for the parties to file briefs, including prehearing testimony, and establishing April 5, 2017 as the hearing date.

On January 31, 2017, Blyncsy notified the PSC that the parties, together with the Division of Public Utilities, stipulate to Blyncsy's withdrawing the complaint without prejudice.

# <u>ORDER</u>

Given the foregoing, the Public Service Commission of Utah dismisses Blyncsy's

September 27, 2016 complaint against Rocky Mountain Power and vacates the December 2,

2016 scheduling order, including the April 5, 2017 hearing date. Dismissal is without prejudice.

Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
