Dear Mr. Lively,

The Commission reviewed the February 25, 2016 filing by PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power, proposing changes to Electric Service Schedule No. 73, Subscriber Solar Program Rider – Optional. The proposed changes to Sheet No. 73.1 of Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 50 (First Revision of Sheet No. 73.1) include decreasing the solar block delivery charge for Schedule 23 from 2.9294 cents per kWh to 2.6958 cents per kWh to reflect distribution revenue from the power charge and minor administrative updates. PacifiCorp states that the proposed changes are being made pursuant to the Commission's October 21, 2015 Order (October Order) in Docket No. 15-035-61 and clarifies that the power charge will continue to be applicable to Schedule 23 customers with usage greater than 15 kW.

The Commission also reviewed the February 29, 2016 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (Division), and comments from the Office of Consumer Services (Office) and Utah Clean Energy (UCE) filed on March 11, 2016. The Division, the Office and UCE recommend the Commission approve PacifiCorp's proposed changes to Sheet No. 73.1. The Division concludes that the proposed change to the Schedule 23 solar block delivery charge complies with the October Order. The Office states that the proposed changes resolve its issues relating to Schedule 23 charges.

Based on the Commission's review of the filing and the recommendations of the Division, the Office and UCE, the First Revision of Sheet No. 73.1 is approved as filed, effective March 28, 2016.
