Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the September 28, 2018 filing (Compliance Filing) by PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), containing revisions to Sheet Nos. 34.1, 34.2, and 34.3 and the addition of Sheet No 34.4 to Electric Service Schedule No. 34, Renewable Energy Purchases for Qualified Customers – 5,000 kW and Over (Schedule 34). PacifiCorp states that the proposed revisions to Schedule 34 were made pursuant to the PSC's August 31, 2018 Order (Order) in this docket, and incorporate the changes recommended by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) in its August 1, 2018 filing. PacifiCorp asserts the DPU's recommended changes are supported by PacifiCorp and the Office of Consumer Services.

The PSC also reviewed the October 5, 2018 comments filed by the DPU. The DPU determines that PacifiCorp's Compliance Filing correctly incorporates the changes approved by the PSC in the Order. The DPU concludes that PacifiCorp's revisions to Schedule 34 comply with the Order and recommends the PSC approve them.

Based on the PSC's review of PacifiCorp's Compliance Filing and the DPU's recommendation, and there being no objection to the filing, the PSC approves the proposed revisions to Schedule 34 Sheet Nos. 34.1, 34.2, 34.3, and the addition of Sheet No. 34.4 to PacifiCorp's P.S.C.U. No. 50 Tariff, effective August 31, 2018.
