Walter Pera, a citizen of the State of Utah, resident and property owner in the city of Holladay and a PacifiCorp (dba Rocky Mountain Power) customer with an installed net-metering solar system, is hereby requesting leave to intervene in the above-entitled matter pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §63G-4-207 and Utah Admin. R746-100-7.


Justification for the approval of this petition are outlined below.

- Walter Pera, as a customer of Pacificorp has a vested interest in the outcome of the above titled matter.
- The commission has the duty to allow all interested parties to participate to fullest degree in the hearing process.
- Pacificorp has indicated the current customers will be grandfathered for the present time; however, Pacificorp has clearly indicated this is only temporary "The Company expects this issue to be considered in a future proceeding. "

- Walter Pera believes Pacificorp has unfairly given less weight to the benefits of solar power, and is unfairly singling out this customer class to gouge them with charges that don't apply.
- At this time, the relief sought by intervening is to obtain access to the documents supporting the rate increase contained in the Docket and to request a limited amount of discovery. I will review these documents thoroughly to conduct an independent analysis of the impacts to the single-family homeowners wishing to or have installed solar energy. After conducting this analysis, further efforts may be warranted including working with the division, preparing and submitting testimony and participation in the formal hearing proceedings.
- Walter Pera is making this request in order to present the commission with a fair and unbiased study of the costs and effects of the solar panel on the electric utility operation.
- Walter Pera believes this intervention will not harm the prompt and orderly conduct the commission has come to expect.

Walter Pera is respectfully requesting the Commission approve this request for leave to become an intervener in the above referenced matter.
